



## INSTRUCTIONS

We did this cat in soft neutral colors, but you could switch them up easily for a more bold cat. Just choose a light for all over, a medium for the big part of the spot, and a dark color for the small spots.

1. Use a fan brush to apply 3 coats of Beachcomber all over the cat. Allow this to dry before the next step.
2. We are going to make the spots now in two layers. The "inside" of the spot is a lighter color than the rest of the spots. So first use your medium brush to apply spots of Carnation all over. We did smaller spots on the legs and face.
3. Around each of the Carnation spots we are going to put 3 smaller dabs using a detail brush and Coral Reef.
4. Finally we are going to paint 2 coats of Carnation on the nose of the cat.

## TIPS

- When applying the spots, just tap the brush on making imperfect spots.
- We made the spots on the legs and face smaller than the ones on the back.
- We left the chest/belly and the bottom of the face without any spots.
